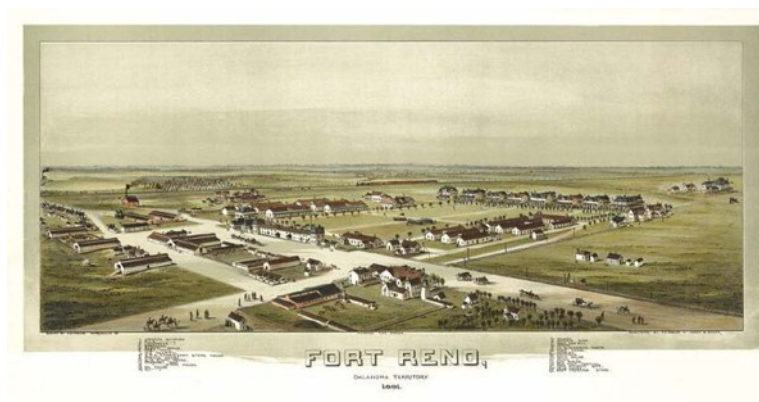

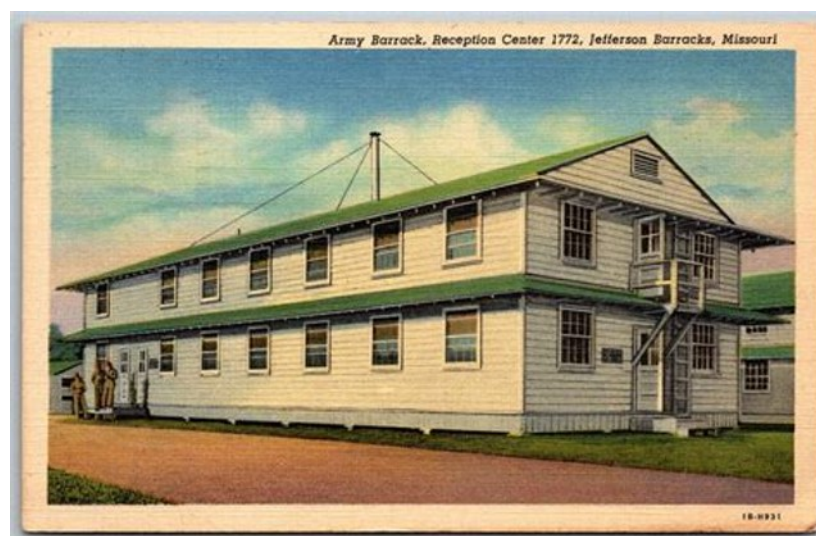


WWI Victory Medal

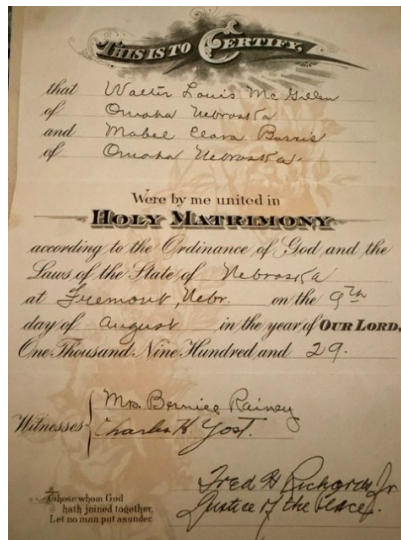
Camp of President Calvin Coolidge Guard, Detachment Third Infantry, Cedar Island Lodge, Brule, Wisconsin, 1928



Fort Amador, Panama Canal Zone 1928

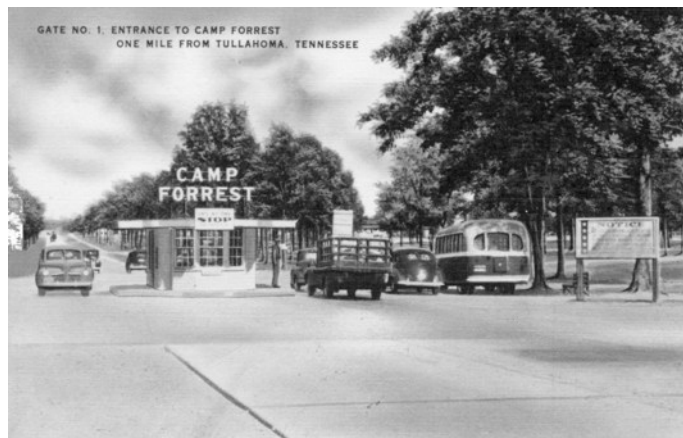

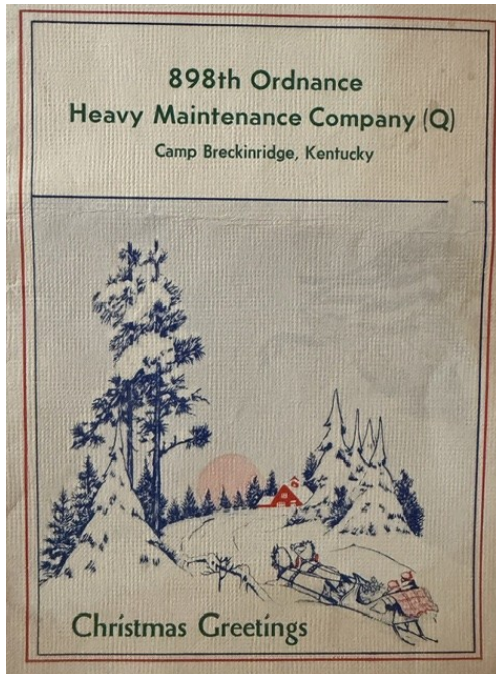


Marriage Certificate 9 August 1929

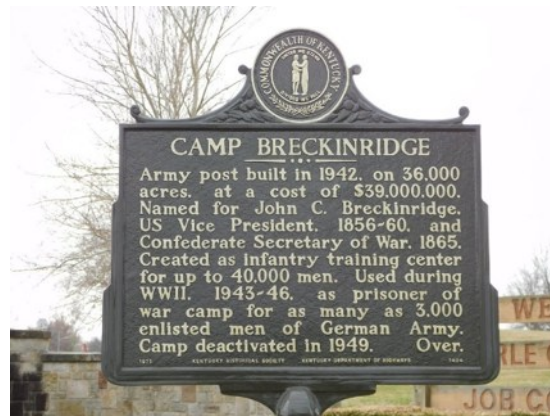

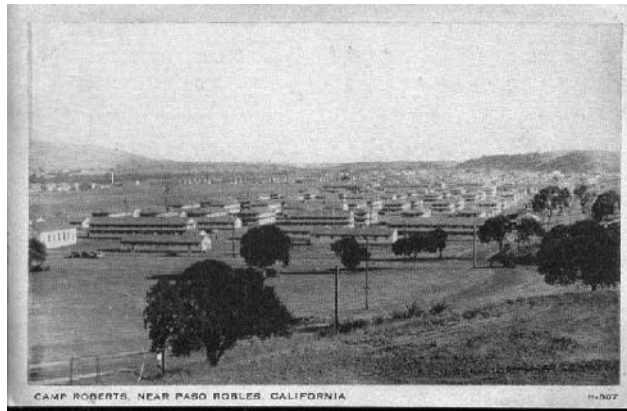
Camp Breckenridge Christmas Dinner 1942

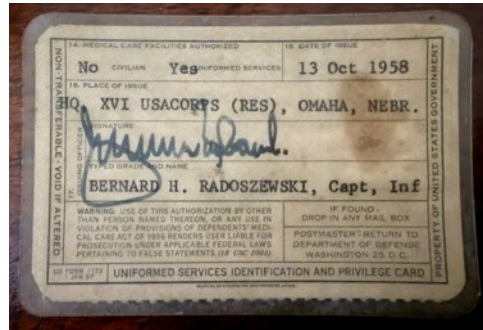
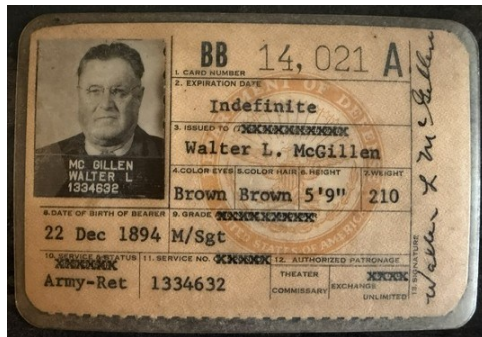
